The Committee on Local Government joint with the Committee on Electoral Reforms and People's Participation will conduct a public hearing on **Wednesday, October 18, 2017, 1 p.m.** at the **Sen. Recto Room, Senate of the Philippines** to deliberate on the following proposed measures:

I. Recap of the bills discussed during the June 5 consultative meeting (without quorum):

a. Reapportionment of Legislative Districts

1. **HB 5162** (Rep. Pedro B. Acharon Jr.) An Act Separating the City of General Santos from the First Legislative District of the Province of South Cotabato to Constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of General Santos and

2. **SB 1487** (Sen. Pacquiao) – An Act Separating the City of General Santos from the First Legislative District of the Province of South Cotabato to Constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of General Santos

b. Cityhood

1. **HB 5160** (Rep. Ma. Theresa P. Collantes) – An Act Converting the Municipality of Sto. Tomas in the Province of Batangas into a Component City to be known as the City of Sto. Tomas

c. Barangay Creation/Division

1. **HB 5220** (Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang) – An Act Separating the Sitios of Ileb, New Colayo Village, Kinama and Nambaran Daya from Barangay Nambaran, City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga and Constituting them into a Separate and Independent Barangay to be known as Barangay Nambaran East
2. **HB 5221** (Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang) – An Act Creating a Barangay to be known as Barangay Ipil in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga
3. **HB 5222** (Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang) – An Act Separating the Sitios of Guina-Ang, Madopdop, Mallango, Lanlana and San Pablo From Barangay Lacnog, City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga and Constituting them into a Separate and Independent Barangay to be known as Barangay Lacnog West
4. **HB 5223** (Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang) – An Act Creating a Barangay to be known as Barangay Bulanao Norte in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga

II. Hearing on the following bills:

a. Reapportionment of Legislative Districts

1. **HB 5367** (Rep. Jun Jun Ferrer) – An Act Reapportioning the Sixth and Seventh Legislative Districts of the Province of Cavite to Create an Additional Legislative District to be known as the Eighth Legislative District of the Province of Cavite

b. Barangay Creation

1. **HB 1926** (Rep. Juliette T. Uy) – An Act Creating a Barangay to be known as Barangay Poblacion 2 in the Municipality of Villanueva, Province of Misamis Oriental

c. Cityhood Conversion Requirements

1. **HB 4149** (Rep. Roy M. Loyola) – An Act Exempting from the Population and Land Area Requirements the Conversion of a Municipality into a Component City if it has a Locally Generated Average Annual Income of at least Two Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P250,000,000.00), amending for the purpose Section 450 of Republic Act No.7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991

2. **HB 2040** (Rep. Cesar V. Sarmiento) – An Act Amending Section 450 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as Amended by Republic Act No. 9009, by Exempting Capital Towns of Provinces without Cities from the Income Requirement set forth therein and for Other Purposes
