RESOLUTION

AREAS CRITICAL TO NATIONAL DEFENSE OF FOREIGNERS USING FALSIFICATION OR UNLAWFULLY-OBTAINED DOCUMENTS, AS WELL AS OTHER SCHEMES, TO POSE POLICY, PUBLIC SAFETY AND NATIONAL SECURITY IMPLICATIONS AND SECURITY, PEACE, UNIFICATION AND RECONCILIATION TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION IN AID OF LEGISLATION INTO THE CALLING FOR THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON NATIONAL DEFENSE AS FILIPINOS, WITH EMPHASIS ON THE CONCENTRATION

regarding the sudden and dramatic influx of foreign nationals into the country, some using falsified or unlawfully-obtained documents to pose as Filipinos; WHEREAS, in the past several months, concerns have been raised
