INTRODUCED BY SENATORS VILLANUEVA AND VILLAR

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE SERVICE CHARGE COLLECTED IN HOTELS AND OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS BE DISTRIBUTED TO ALL COVERED EMPLOYEES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Article 96 of the Labor Code is hereby 2 amended to read as follows:

"ART. 96. Service Charges. – All service charges collected by hotels, restaurants and similar establishments shall be distributed [at the rate of eighty-five percent (85%) for all covered employees and fifteen percent (15%) for management. The share of the employees shall be COMPLETELY AND equally [distributed]

1	among [them] THE COVERED WORKERS
2	EXCEPT MANAGERIAL EMPLOYEES. In
3	case the service charge is abolished, the share
4	of the covered employees shall be considered
5	integrated in their wages.
6	"FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS
7	ARTICLE, MANAGERIAL EMPLOYEES
8	MEANS THOSE WHO ARE VESTED WITH
9	POWERS OR PREROGATIVES TO LAY
10	DOWN AND EXECUTE MANAGEMENT
11	POLICIES AND/OR TO HIRE, TRANSFER,
12	SUSPEND, LAY OFF, RECALL, DISCHARGE,
13	ASSIGN OR DISCIPLINE EMPLOYEES, OR
14	TO EFFECTIVELY RECOMMEND SUCH
15	MANAGERIAL ACTIONS."
16	SEC. 2. Nothing in this Act shall be construed as to
17	diminish existing benefits under present laws, company
18	policies and collective bargaining agreements.
19	SEC. 3. All laws, executive orders, proclamations,
20	presidential decrees, rules and regulations and other

- 1 issuances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the
- 2 provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified
- 3 accordingly.
- 4 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
- 5 after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least
- 6 two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
