

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

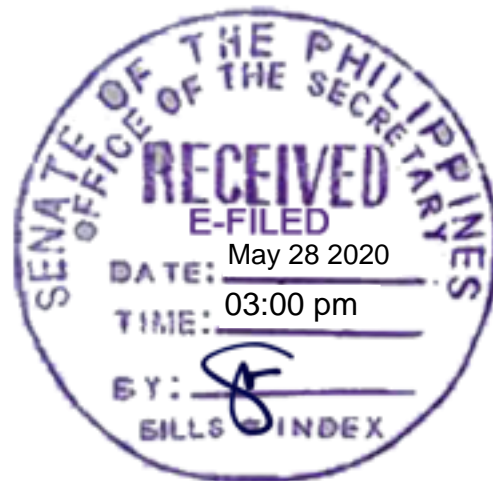

AN ACT
INCREASING THE RECRUITMENT QUOTA REQUIREMENT OF FEMALE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) OFFICERS, AMENDING SECTION 58 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8551, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** Section 58 of Republic Act No. 8551, otherwise known as the
2 "Philippine National Police Reform and Reorganization Act of 1998", is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 **"Sec. 58. *Prioritization of Women for Recruitment.* –**

5 Within the next five (5) years, the PNP shall prioritize the
6 recruitment and training of women who shall serve in the women's
7 desk. Pursuant to this requirement, the PNP shall reserve [ten]
8 **FIFTEEN** percent [(10%)] **(15%)** of its annual recruitment,
9 training, and education quota for women: **PROVIDED, THAT THE**

1 **RECRUITMENT QUOTA FOR WOMEN SHALL BE INCREASED**
2 **TO TWENTY PERCENT (20%) FIVE YEARS THEREAFTER.”**

3 **SEC. 2. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.*** – Within ninety (90) days
4 from the effectivity of this Act, the National Police Commission in coordination with
5 the PNP and the Department of the Interior and Local Government, shall formulate
6 the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

7 **SEC. 3. *Separability Clause.*** – If any part, section or provision of this Act
8 is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the sections or provisions which are not
9 affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

10 **SEC. 4. *Repealing Clause.*** – All laws, decrees, ordinances, rules,
11 regulations, other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are
12 hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

13 **SEC. 5. *Effectivity Clause.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
14 after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
15 circulation.
