The Update is meant to inform the public of the laws approved by the President of the Philippines and the bills passed by the Senate and forwarded to the House of Representatives for concurrence/approval.

This publication aims to inform and update concerned Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and the public on Senate bills filed per month and their committee(s) referrals.
